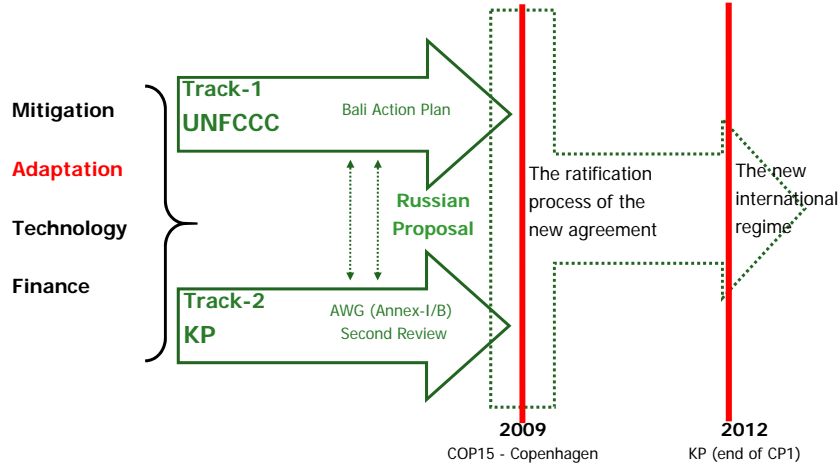
## Local Government Climate Roadmap

- **Lobby** for a **comprehensive post-2012** global climate **agreement**.
- **Offer partnership** to National Governments to limit global warming.
- **Recognition of the Local Government's role** in climate protection
- **Mobilising Leadership** in Local Climate Action.

### Major activities;

- Development of and lobbying for a COP Decision
- COP14, Local Government Climate Sessions
- 2 April; UNFCCC Side Event on National – Local Dialogue
- 2-4 June; Local Government Climate Summit, Copenhagen
- UNFCCC Sessions; June, August, September and COP15 Copenhagen
